RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR EXPLORING, IN COORDINATION WITH AND **SUBJECT** TO THE AGREEMENT OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY COLLECTOR ("TAX COLLECTOR"), THE INCLUSION ON OR WITH THE ANNUAL TAX NOTICE OF A VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION OPTION THROUGH WHICH TAXPAYERS COULD SUPPORT COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS AND CULTURAL PROGRAMS WITHIN THE COUNTY; INVITING THE TAX COLLECTOR TO JOIN THIS BOARD IN ADVANCING THIS INITIATIVE; AUTHORIZING COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TAX COLLECTOR AS NECESSARY; AND DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD TO TRANSMIT A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS RESOLUTION TO THE TAX COLLECTOR FOR CONSIDERATION AND POTENTIAL IMPLEMENTATION

WHEREAS, community-based organizations (CBOs) help the County reach residents with important services provided in homes, schools, community centers, churches, parks and more; and

WHEREAS, CBOs provide jobs and contribute to our local economy by mobilizing community resources that add tremendous value to other County investments in our community; and

WHEREAS, through the CBO Grant Program, administered by the Office of Management and Budget, the County allocates more than \$15,000,000.00 annually to support human and social services delivered by nonprofit CBOs; and

WHEREAS, additionally, the County's wide array of cultural programs, including grant opportunities, arts education initiatives, and community-based arts events—all managed by the Department of Cultural Affairs—aim to enrich the lives of residents and visitors by promoting arts, culture, and heritage; and

WHEREAS, events like the Miami Book Fair, Miami Film Festival, and various art festivals celebrating the diverse heritage of the region, foster Miami-Dade County's vibrant arts and cultural scene; and

WHEREAS, this Board believes it would be in the best interests of the County to explore, in partnership with the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector, the inclusion of a voluntary contribution option with the annual tax notice sent to taxpayers, providing a convenient way for residents to support CBOs and cultural programs within the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Expresses its support for exploring, in coordination with and subject to the agreement of the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector, the feasibility and design of including a voluntary contribution option on or with the annual tax notice, enabling taxpayers to make monetary contributions to community-based organizations and cultural programs within the County.

Section 2. Invites the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector to consider joining this Board in advancing this initiative in a manner that is accessible, transparent, and aligned with community priorities, while preserving the Tax Collector's sole discretion over implementation.

Section 3. Authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute an interlocal agreement with the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector, as may be necessary and in coordination with the County Attorney's Office, to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.

Section 4. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector.
