The Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) within the Department of Commerce is charged with administering the provisions of the Export Administration Regulations (15 CFR 730-774 (EAR)), under the authority of the Export Control Reform Act of 2018, 50 U.S.C. 4801-4852.

Under the authority of § 750.8 of the EAR, BIS is partially revoking license D1343239, specifically, the authorization for Martel Express US Corp to export, reexport and/or transfer JACUZZIS designated under EAR99 to Mika S.R.L. in Cuba. BIS is taking this action following a determination that inclusion of these items on this license is not in the current foreign policy interests of the United States.

Effective as of the date of this letter, license D1343239 is partially revoked to remove authorization to export, reexport, and/or transfer JACUZZIS designated under EAR99. You will no longer be able to use your license to export these items. Any shipments currently in transit, pursuant to the above-referenced license, must be returned to the United States or otherwise redirected or halted in a manner consistent with the EAR. The license will remain valid for all other export items identified on the license. You will receive a message via e-mail alerting you of the change in status to your license. Please access your account in BIS's license submission portal (SNAP-R) to verify the partial revocation of your license.

Pursuant to part 756 of the EAR, you may appeal this revocation to the Under Secretary for Industry and Security. Any such appeal must be received no later than 45 days after the date of this letter and must include a written supporting statement of why BIS should reverse or modify this revocation decision.
